The multi-Grammy-nominated artist has performed to critical acclaim throughout the world as orchestral soloist, recitalist, and chamber musician.

Complementing the program will be two-time Tony Award winner and Broadway sensation **Sutton Foster**, who will also grace the stage of Symphony Hall for an evening that explores the Great American Songbook and beyond.
